Newcomers: Luis, Menno, Tim







Problems Encountered


- Wiring
 - We've run about 1km of UTP cable around the meeting area to build the network
- Initial connectivity problems on Sunday morning
 - Announcing the RIPE Meeting address range from a new location always causes some problems
 - Configuration of Etisalat proxies
- Power outage on Wednesday morning
 - Took out our main switch and our transit link
 - Our BGP announcement from Etisalat to the rest of the world was not immediately reinstated following the outage.

- Peak approximately 30 Mbps


