Background

- RIRs active in WSIS (World Summit on Information Society)
 - Beginning of current Multi-stakeholder approach to Internet Governance
 - Established the Technical Community as a legitimate stakeholder (in addition to Civil Society, Business)
 - Together with many industry partners - RIRs, ISOC, ICANN, IETF, ...
- Continue to cooperate in different areas of common interest

- Three components
 - Public consultation on agenda and objectives
 - Multi-Stakeholder Advisory Group
 - IGF meeting
- MAG (50 Members)
 - Initially for logisitics, now driving program content
 - 2 RIR Directors (Adiel Akplogan, Raul Echeberria)
- Past IGF Meetings (Athens, Rio de Janeiro)
- Local IGF Meetings (UK, DE, RU)

- Next Steps in Relations
 - Proposal for creation of Internet Technical Advisory Committee (ITAC) - Nov 2008
 - Together with 16 industry partners
 - Solid input from RIPE NCC, APNIC, ARIN
 - Proposal delivery at ICCP Meeting in Dec 2008



RIPE NCC Roundtable Meetings

- 6 Roundtable Meetings since 2005
- Last Meeting - Sept 2008
 - Government + RIPE Community Members
 - Topics: IP address registration, IPv4 exhaustion, IP policies overview, criminal activity on the Internet
 - 26 gov't representatives from 11 countries
- Future meetings
 - 2 meetings per year (February / September)
- Messages & Press coverage targeted at government (Racepoint)

 - Delivered at RIPE 56 in Berlin

 - Geneva, Nov 2008

 - Regular meetings in Brussels
