### **Background**

- Production IPv6 meeting network
  - For a few years already, requested by the community
  - Started at experimentation level, now of production quality
  - Is set up at different locations
- Workarounds so far
  - Used part of our /42 assignment from SURFnet block
  - Used a /32 temporarily assigned by Telecity Deutschland
- No policy to support this case

#### **Policy proposal**

- An IPv6 Assignment for RIPE meeting network
  - Assigned to a meeting organiser
    - Currently the RIPE NCC
  - Used only for RIPE meetings
  - Has to be returned to the RIPE NCC if conditions cease to exist
- Size of the assignment is /48

Database status is "ASSIGNED MEETING"





#### **Rationale**

- Need an independent permanent assignment
  - The network is set up at different locations
  - Very limited time to configure and test
- Very specific purpose
  - It's a community thing!
- /48
  - Ensure connectivity
  - Simplify routing setup
